Information for event guests

Please find below details about what is happening on the 2022 Legend Fires North West Stages, when and where it's happening.

On Friday 18th March the formalities of pre-event scrutineering and documentation will take place at the Rally Headquarters, Myerscough College, St Michael's Road, Bilsborrow, Preston, PR3 0RY starting at 12:00 hours.

Then from around 18:30 hours the evening spectacle of the event Ceremonial Start will commence with the first of the competition cars arriving in Garstang High Street along with the Samba Espirito band. There will be interviews with event organisers and dignitaries, school colouring competition winners presentation, driver interviews on the start ramp and cars flagged away by the Councillor Alec Allan, Garstang Town Council Mayor and the Youth Mayor of Garstang, Declan Stephen.

On Saturday morning the first competing car will leave Myerscough at 08:45, flagged away by Councillor Andrea Kay, Mayor of Wyre, and the competition will continue throughout the day with crews tackling a total of 14 Special Stages.

New for 2022, at the finish of the rally, cars will return to Garstang High Street at around 18:40 for celebration champagne spraying for the top three finishers with drivers interviewed on the ramp about their rally experience. All other finishers will also drive through the High Street with many being interviewed when crossing the finishing ramp. The Samba Espirito band will return to guide the winners to the podium. The formal Awards Presentation will take place at about 21:00 hours at Guys Thatched Hamlet, in the Tommy Hatton Room.

See map on page 5 – please follow the purple route to access the hospitality area. You will be able to park on Delph Lane and there are also parking spaces in the Church Hall Car Park. Please note - you will need to show your car pass in order to get access past the road closure and your individual pass to gain access to the hospitality area.

In order to access the guest area safely, please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the due start time for the first car, see table on page 2. As times may vary throughout the day, updated times can be found on the web site at http://www.northweststages.co.uk/residents/nicky-nook

See map on page 6 for access to the stage and car parking. Follow the blue arrows but for event guests you will continue to the junction marked 5 where you will be allowed past the second closure. Please note that the hospitality area is within the competitive special stage closed road and so to access the area it is imperative that you arrive prior to the passage of the safety cars before the stage is live. Guidance is included on the time schedule included in the table on page 2, but as times may vry throughout the day, updated times can be found on the web site at http://www.northweststages.co.uk/residents/beacon-fell

In order to access the guest area, you must be at the stage access (as shown on the map marked Access Closes) at least 1 hour 20 minutes before the due time for Car 1 or the road will be closed.






